RAINBOW READING CHALLENGE

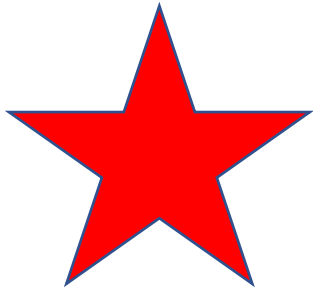
The aim of this challenge is to read books from each colour of the rainbow.

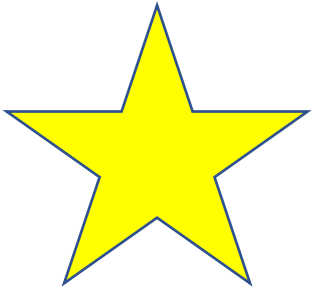

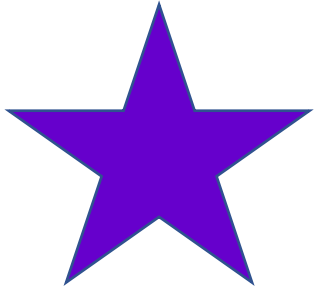

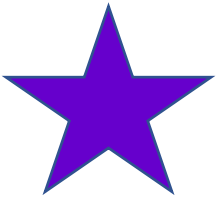
